The Office of Institutional Research supports and advances data-informed decision making so that Boise State can continue to improve as an institution and achieve its goals as a metropolitan research university of distinction.

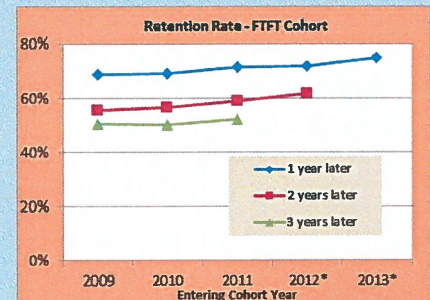
What We Do
