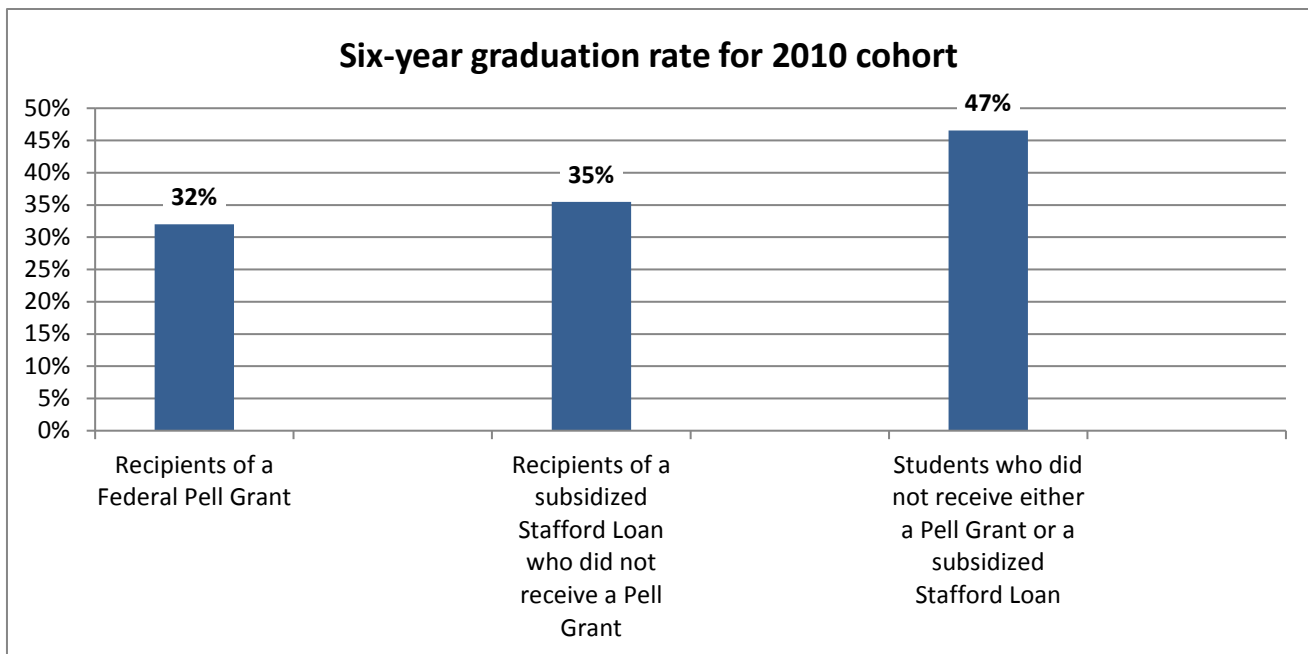

Initial 2010 cohort of first-time, full-time, bachelor's (or equivalent) degree-seeking undergraduate students.	998	327	972
Four-year graduates - Of the initial 2010 cohort, how many did not persist and did not graduate for the following reasons: deceased, permanently disabled, armed forces, foreign aid service of the federal government, or official church missions; total allowable exclusions.	5	0	3
Final 2010 cohort, after adjusting for allowable exclusions.	993	327	969
Total graduating within six years (sum of 4-, 5-, and 6-year graduate counts)	318	116	451
Six-year graduation rate for 2010 cohort	32%	35%	47%
